

## Minutes of the OLA General Meeting, May 28, 2011

The meeting was called to order by President Mona Lincoln, followed by the pledge of Allegiance, led by Hubert Velepec.

Question from the floor asking why dumpster day is no longer held at the church. Traffic concerns and the mess left behind.

President Lincoln went on to say she had attended Grievance day to oppose the raising of our tax from \$2300.00 to \$41,000.00. She won!!! It was reversed to the original amount.

Two thank you notes were received: OLFD for our \$100.00 donation and a representative from Little Long Lake for help gaining information about the carp project.

New Business: Mona introduced newly appointed, Gabrielle Lodder, who is filling a board vacancy left by Camille Foote. Also Gene Tremble, generously offered to fill out the term of Ann Wright.

Steve Surace said work needed to be done at the launch and asked if fill could be used. Dick Gloop mentioned the washout behind Brian's (standard Supply). Mona is contacting Brian and we will resolve the launch dilemma.

Questions, concerns and suggestions were taken regarding the upcoming Fishing Derby, from Gene Webster and Patrick Mullally. Small children could perhaps cast only into a pool..barbless hooks should be used and genuine concern for the loss of many fish, if it's not catch and release and how could they then be easily measured. The committee will meet with Mr. Webster's assistance and try to work out these issues.

Gene Webster was asked to photograph lakeshore boathouses which will be filed at the Woodgate Library. said the Woodhull and Remsen Falls rd are safe.

Bonnie Bravo won the 50/50 raffle and gave it back to the association. The issue of Lakeview Rd. vs. Lakeview Dr. came up. Apparently the town, only, uses Lakeview Dr. The Post Office prefers using Lakeview Rd. as do most businesses.
